His disciples did not understand these things at first, but when Jesus was glorified, then they remembered that these things had been written about him and had been done to him (John 12:16).


The King is Coming!

It's easy to prepare for an LWML Sunday event with free downloads. You'll find bulletin covers, a full worship service, sermon and children's message, powerpoint template and more!




