



They have a full sized beautiful blanket and a very meaningful devotion book to be given to parents who have lost a baby through miscarriage or stillbirth. They can be donated to a pregnancy care center such as Lifeline in Nampa or Treasure Valley PATH in Boise or given to a local hospital.

It is helpful to have a contact person in your congregation to receive and distribute the boxes. If you are a Thrivent member, you are able to receive one box a year for each person in the family who is a Thrivent participant.

Everything from helping hands at the Idaho Food Bank (both September and November) to a Teacher Appreciation Breakfast for the staff of Grace Lutheran schools. The Zone Event in September had a good turnout – with many items collected for the local Veterans' Home (puzzles to quilts, playing cards to CDs) and several went home with goodie boxes for Operation Christmas Child. They continue with a monthly Bible study for school moms and the Prayer Shawl ministry, along with making plans for supporting area seniors with Christmas gifts in the works for December.

They hosted their annual Craft and Bake Sale for the benefit of Corey Walsted (to support his education as an SMP Pastor for Rigby's Crown of Thorns), Noah Oloff (in his freshman year of seminary in St. Louis), and for LCMS Disaster Relief (for the Maui Hawaii fire). Plans for December include serving for a soup supper one evening of the Advent devotions, along with continuing their monthly Bible study (with a bit of a meeting) and Ladies Lunch Out (which is enjoyed by many).


