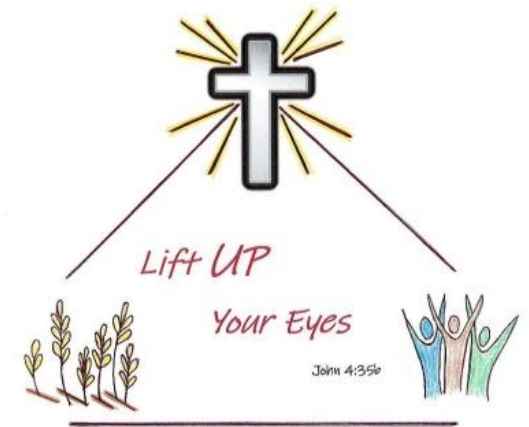
## CONVENTION LOGO

When creating the 2020 LWML District Convention logo, I addressed the whole verse of John 4:35 rather than the theme alone – Lift Up Your Eyes.
